### Online Learning

Integrating today's high-tech capabilities with proven educational methodologies, DeVry University delivers courses and degree programs online via the Internet. Student academic performance for online courses is assessed via thorough evaluation of contributions to team/group activities, participation in threaded discussions and performance on individual assignments. By combining these activities with results from online quizzes and exams, instructors build complete portfolios reflecting students' mastery of course objectives.

DeVry University also integrates web-based tools into site-based courses. This "best of both worlds" advantage increases the effectiveness of the learning environment while better meeting the needs of students with varied learning styles and needs.
