China Firm locates North American Headquarters in Chesapeake

Touchroad International Trading Ltd. Locates in Greenbrier Business Park

CHESAPEAKE, VA - The City of Chesapeake, Virginia announced today that Shanghai Touchroad International Trading Ltd., a manufacturer of textiles and jewelry, has established its U.S. headquarters in the City of Chesapeake.

Touchroad International Holdings (U.S.A.), a division of Touchroad International Trading Ltd, will begin operations of a 5,000 square foot warehouse/distribution/showroom in the City of Chesapeake's Greenbrier Business Park this May and will open a 1,000 square foot retail jewelry store on Granby Street in the City of Norfolk scheduled for June. A total of six people will be initially hired to run each business.

Mr. He Liehui, Managing Director of the company said that Hampton Roads stood out among other East Coast locations as a centrally located site for his headquarter operations. "Hampton Roads is in close proximity to a number of our major markets in the U.S. while the Port of Virginia will serve our international transportation requirements. Hampton Roads Economic Development Alliance (HREDA) has been extremely responsive in meeting all of our needs to implement our U.S. business plan. I look forward to strengthening our relationship with HREDA and Hampton Roads communities in order to assist other Chinese companies in locating to Virginia."

Alliance team members initially met with Mr. He in September 2005 on a marketing mission to Shanghai, China. Impressed with the presentation in Shanghai, Mr. He and a representative from his Canadian operations first visited Hampton Roads in late September to learn more about the region and operating a business in the U.S. During that visit, Mr. He met with the HREDA International Roundtable. The International Roundtable is a S.W.A.T. team of sorts consisting of lawyers, accountants, bankers and human resource experts that meet with a foreign client to discuss the fundamentals of establishing and running a business in the U.S.

“Meeting with members of the International Roundtable was extremely helpful to me in understanding the nuances involved with starting a business in Virginia and Hampton Roads. I continue to consult with members of the roundtable for advice on certain issues,” explained Mr. He.

According to Dalton S. Edge, Mayor of Chesapeake, “We are honored and pleased that Mr. He has chosen the City of Chesapeake as the location for his company’s U.S. operations. This decision substantiates our efforts to create a world class business environment in Chesapeake. We are proud to have Shanghai Touchroad become the first Chinese company to join our international business community.”

Chesapeake is consistently ranked as one of the country’s best places for international business investment. The City is home to the largest concentration of the region’s foreign businesses, with over 80 firms representing at least 20 countries.

Franklin R. Bowers, Chairman of the Hampton Roads Economic Development Alliance added, “We are especially excited about the first Chinese company recruited to the region by our marketing team. This is a crucial step in our efforts to promote Hampton Roads to the highly active Chinese marketplace. The Alliance will continue to explore other opportunities in China this spring with a mission and a seminar in Shanghai.”
